Vendor Terms of Agreement



Aggressive or abusive behaviour towards or treatment of CIFN staff, vendors, and market patrons will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the event, immediately. There will be no refund issued if a vendor is removed

from the event.

 Most items (60%) must be handcrafted (make it, bake it, raise it, harvest it) or locally grown.

Set-up time begins one-and-one-half hours before the market start.

 PLEASE do not arrive earlier than set-up time (8:30am) as we need to prepare the venue space the morning of the market.

 All tables will have seating for two people. Tables must remain in the configuration set upon arrival. Additional tables are not permitted.

Tear-down time begins at 5:00 pm and ends at 6:00 pm.

 Vendors are responsible for CLEANING their sites at the end of the Market Day: this includes removing ANY and ALL vendor garbage.

If you are selling food, your items MUST be pre-packaged in take-out

containers, and not sold for immediate consumption.

- All prepared food vendors must familiarize themselves with the Guideline for the Sale of Foods at Temporary Food Markets. Vendors applying to sell high risk items will need to apply for a permit from the First Nations Health Authority or other valid BC Health Authority. Vendors of prepared food items must ensure their product is safe and do any necessary testing to prove such.
- Vendors please submit a copy of your valid Food Safe Certificate or valid health permit with your registration.
- Vendors must prominently display an appropriate sign with their name. Signs must show, at the very least, the vendor's name (or business name).

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- Please advise ASAP of any cancellation so we have the opportunity to offer your booth to a wait-listed vendor.
- Vendors who cancel will be subject to a minimal cancellation fee.
- There are no refunds after October 27, 2024.
